

Dear Sophia,

Our dogs come from high-kill shelters all over the West Coast. These shelters are often overcrowded, and the odds of adoption may be low. Many have been abandoned by owners who can no longer care for them—a problem that has increased dramatically during the COVID-19 pandemic, as the poor economy and sometimes debilitating or deadly nature of the diseases has left many dogs without homes. Your contributions will save the lives of thousands of dogs who might otherwise be killed at shelters if they are not adopted within a certain time frame.

Oregon Dog Rescue saved over 1,800 dogs in 2019. Since our first adoption in 2007, we have helped over 8,000 pups find their forever homes. Our shelter is “no-kill,” so the dogs stay with us until they find their families.

While at Oregon Dog Rescue, our special guests spend their days in playrooms where they can interact and socialize with staff, volunteers and prospective families. Staff members assess each dog to determine what type of family would be best, and we work hard to match these dogs with the right family. We are proud of our facility, our team and our mission.

We have found that by taking a few key steps with every animal, the odds of a successful adoption increase significantly. We spay or neuter every dog, bring their vaccinations up-to-date and microchip every animal so that they can be reunited with their new families should they get lost sometime in the future.

In-Kind Donations


These are physical items we always need. Consider donating them as well.
